Behaviour Policies

Chiltern Futsal Ltd expects all members, parents, and staff to act as positive ambassadors for the club at all times. Everyone shares responsibility for promoting safety, respect, and professionalism.

1. Players' Code of Behaviour

Players must: - Arrive on time, prepared, and wearing **full Chiltern Futsal kit** (no other club colours).

- Treat teammates, opponents, and officials with **respect**.
- Use **positive and appropriate language** at all times.
- Report any safety issues or bullying concerns to their coach or welfare officer.
- Maintain **good appearance and clean footwear**.
- Never attend sessions **under the influence** of alcohol or substances.
- Follow all instructions from coaches and respect game officials.

2. Spectators & Parents' Code of Behaviour

Parents and spectators must: - Show **encouragement and support** for all players, not just their own child.

- Never engage in offensive, abusive, or intimidating behaviour.
- **Refrain from coaching** from the sidelines.
- Respect match officials, coaches, and players at all times.
- Report any safeguarding or welfare concerns appropriately.
- Promote the values and reputation of Chiltern Futsal Ltd.

3. Coaches & Officials' Code of Behaviour

Coaches and officials must: - Represent **Chiltern Futsal Ltd** with professionalism and pride.

- Use **appropriate**, **respectful language**, especially in front of children.
- Follow all **health and safety procedures**, including goal assembly and equipment checks.
- Maintain current FA DBS, Safeguarding, and First Aid certification.
- Prioritise player safety and wellbeing above all else.
- Refer stressful or conflict situations to management.
- Model **positive**, **kind**, **and responsible behaviour** at all times.

4. Shared Responsibility

All members are ambassadors for Chiltern Futsal Ltd. The club will address any breaches of conduct and may take disciplinary action if required to maintain a safe and respectful environment.
